Phonics

Week 7

You will need paper and a pen/pencil. Use the letter formation sheet to help you.

Session 1: Speed Sound: k

- **1.Say the sound.** Bounce k-k-k. Make a sharp click at the back of your throat. Ask your child to repeat. As for k-k-k-key, k-k-k-kettle, k-k-k-kite, k-k-k-k kitchen.
- **2.Read the sound**. Write a k and next to it draw a kangaroo. Run your finger in the shape of a k and say k-k-k-k.
- 3. Repeat this several times.
- **4.Air-write the letter.** Air-write k, saying "down the kangaroo's body, tail and leg" as you form the letter in the air with your finger. Repeat several times.
- **5.Fred Talk.** Remind your child that Fred can only say words in sounds and not the whole word.
- 6.Say each word below in Fred talk. Ask your child to repeat. Allow your child to jump in and say the whole word if they can.

k-i-t kit, b-a-ck back, k-i-ss kiss, s-a-ck sack.

Remember to practise "m, a, s, d, t, i, n, p, g, o and c" from previous weeks too.

Session 2

1.Say the sound. Bounce k-k-k. Make a sharp click at the back of your throat. Ask your child to repeat. As for k-k-k-key, k-k-k-kettle, k-k-k-kite, k-k-k-k kitchen.

- **2.Read the sound**. Write a k and next to it draw a kangaroo. Run your finger in the shape of a k and say k-k-k-k.
- 3. Repeat this several times.
- **4.Air-write the letter.** Air-write k, saying "down the kangaroo's body, tail and leg" as you form the letter in the air with your finger. Repeat several times.
- **5.Fred Talk.** Remind your child that Fred can only say words in sounds and not the whole word.
- 6.Say each word below in Fred talk. Ask your child to repeat. Allow your child to jump in and say the whole word if they can.

k-i-t kit, b-a-ck back, k-i-ss kiss, s-a-ck sack.

7. Write the sound. Put some flour on a baking tray. Show your child how to make the sound in the flour saying the rhyme. Repeat several times. You could use rice, shaving foam, lentils etc.

Session 3

- **1. Sound hunt.** Go for a sound hunt around your house. Can you find things that begin with k.
- **2. Write the sound.** Practise writing the sound. You could use a paintbrush and water, paint, crayons, felt pens. Remember to keep making the sound as you write.

Session 4

Draw the objects. Can you draw the objects you have found beginning with k?

1. Write the sound. Can you have a go at writing the sound?

Session 5

Kim's Game

Play a version of Kim's Game using the objects you have found beginning with 'k'. Lay the objects out and look at them carefully. Cover the objects with a tea towel. Ask your child to cover their eyes while you remove one object. Can they guess which object you have removed? Put the object back and play again removing a different object each time.
