<p>Continue your morning routine, similar to the beginning of the day in Nursery.</p> <p>Sing the days of the week song, talk about the weather and count the number of people in your house.</p>	<p>Try some activities in your blue book.</p> <p>This week – complete the pencil control sheet, name writing, number formation and draw a picture of your family.</p>	<p>Sing <i>Five Little Men in a Flying Saucer</i>.</p> <p>Can you show your family the actions? Can you add some new actions? (Please see the song sheet).</p>	<p>Look for bugs in your garden or outside your home. What can you find? Do they have legs? How many? Can they fly? Where were they? (remember to put them back where you found them). Can you draw one of the bugs in your book or on paper?</p>
<p>Play hide and seek in your home or garden. The children love to play this game in Nursery.</p> <p>Take turns to count to ten while everyone hides. Can you get the whole family to play?</p>	<p>Look out of your window. Can you see and hear any birds? With some help, look at the RSPB website and see if you can find out what they are called. In your book or on paper write some of the bird names together.</p>	<p>Make number cards for the numbers up to ten.</p> <p>Can you recognise the numbers in and out of order. Can you count objects and then find the matching numeral?</p>	<p>Share lots of books. You could look at picture books together and you could also share information books. What can you find out about?</p>
