Maths

Session 1- In this session they will learn to add to make 10.

Session 2- In this session they will subtract within 20.

Session 3- In this session, they will complete addition and subtraction word problems.

Session 4- In this session, they will compare number sentences

Session 5- This session is a challenge session that should be live by the end of the week. Show off what you have learnt.

English

This week we will be focusing on spelling rules. We will look at how to correctly add the suffixes 'ing' and 'ed' to verbs. Please see attached plan for the 5 sessions and resources to accompany them.

Phonics and Reading

Please refer to the document 'Speed Sounds Until Half Term' for the sounds that will be covered this week. Ideally, all children should be watching the set 2 and set 3 'Speed Sounds and Word Time' and 'Spelling' sessions. If your child needs some additional support, the Set 1 sessions can be used as well.

Don't forget Storytime with Nick on Monday, Wednesday and Friday at 2.00pm.

There will be new sounds available to practise on Spelling Shed this week linked to this week's phonics sounds and also the spelling rules we are learning in English, which are 'ed' and 'ing' suffix words.

Wider Curriculum (Topic)

This week we will be focusing on some PSHE. We will be thinking about how we are similar and different to other people which will include our family networks. We will be learning about the importance of rules and why they are put in place. We will also be thinking about how to stay safe at home and in the sun.
