

SPaG Treasure Hunt: Teacher Guidance

The aim of this activity is for the children to hunt down all of the questions that have been placed around the space and to complete their given answer sheet.

Preparation

Cut out the question strips and display them around the classroom or outdoors.

How to play

- Provide each child with an answer sheet and a pencil.
- Give pairs or small groups of children a different starting symbol each. This is the question strip they must find first.
- Children hunt around the space for a question strip that contains their given symbol.
- When they find the question strip, they read the question and try to work out the answer.
- Next, they find the matching symbol on their answer sheet and write the answer in the empty box next to it.
- To find out if they have answered it correctly, they must then hunt for the next symbol on their answer sheet. This strip will contain the correct answer and their next question.
- The children carry on moving around in this way finding and answering questions and checking their answers until all the answer boxes are complete on their sheet.
