PSHE home learning 06/07/20 - Year Two

This week, the children will be planning an experiment about the growth of a plant. By the end of the week, we'd like the children to plant a seed and watch them grow. We're very aware that not everyone will have access to seeds or somewhere to plant – this is only optional however, it is something we would do in school.

Session 1 – The Cautious Caterpillar

What do you think this story will be about? Do you know what the word cautious means? Dissect the word 'ous' is a suffix, so what is the root word? (caution) What type of word do you think this is? (adjective).

Read the story with someone in your family, maybe practise using echo reading with them? You could take turns reading a sentence or paragraph, maybe listen to someone read it to you and then you can read it back?

<u>Remember</u> – reading the book more than once will build your reading confidence and reading fluency.

Session 2- The Cautious Caterpillar

Read the story again today, hopefully your reading will be more fluent than yesterday's session!

Use the 'prompt questions' PDF to work through the questions with someone (or yourself) in your work books, making note of your answers. Think about how this story might help us overcome our fears of moving up to Year 3.

Session 3- The Cautious Caterpillar

Using the differentiated reading comprehension, answer the questions on the back (make sure you focus on your inference and prediction skills – you must be clear with your answers!)

The comprehensions are differentiated by stars at the bottom of the page:

1 star – unconfident reader

2 stars - fairly confident reader

3 stars – confident reader (*at this time of the year, we should aim for 3 stars!*) The answers to the questions are also included.

Session 4 + 5 – The Cautious Caterpillar

To begin our transition journey, we are going to begin our year 2 to 3 transition booklet. These can be kept and given to your next teacher when you arrive in September.

Don't forget, when you submit your work on Google Classroom, you can add extra comments that are private and to the teacher. This way, you can share with us your worries and we can talk

through them together. Although we aren't seeing each other right now, we're still your teachers at the moment!

There is a word search you can do too, just as an extra bit of fun! $\ensuremath{\textcircled{\sc only}}$
