Session 1 – Season Swap

From the title and the front cover, can you predict type of book this is, fiction or nonfiction? What clues are there to tell you what type of book this is?

What might it be talking about? Write down your predictions in your books.

What do you know about seasons? How many are there and what can you tell us about them?

DO NOT READ THE BOOK IN THIS SESSION.

Session 2-

Remind yourselves of your predictions from yesterday. Today, you are going to read the book and see if your definitions of seasons are correct. Is there any more information you should add to your definitions?

Read the story with someone in your family, maybe practise using echo reading with them?

Remember – reading the book more than once will build your reading confidence and reading fluency.

Session 3- read through the story one last time, have you been able to acknowledge all punctuation when reading?

Using the text, we'd like you to make a poster of the top facts that you have read and all about seasons. Make sure your poster has:

- 1) Definitions for each season
- 2) Colour to make it eye-catching
- 3) Capital letters
- 4) Clear information
