



Summer Week 1 - Home Learning

To my English group,

I hope you had a lovely Easter break and are returning to your 'virtual' classroom feeling rested and refreshed. I am looking forward to seeing some of your work in your books when you get back and to hear about all the stories you have read.

Below you will find an explanation of the learning I have set you for this week. All this learning can be completed in your notebook you took home from school or one you have at home. This is a good chance to practise your handwriting! Also, you can edit it on the computer and save the changes. This way you don't need to print anything off and can still share your learning with me by uploading the edited document or a photo of the work to Google Classroom. A letter went out on the 30th March to explain how to do this.

English

Session 1- Spellings- Please practise the common exception words in the activity booklet, completing the activities to help. Once you have done this, continue to practise the spellings throughout the week, writing them out and writing sentences. Once you are confident, ask someone at home to test you on them. Let me know how you do. You can also continue practising all of the common exception words and completing the Mr Whoops activities (in the folder English work w/c 30/03/20) if you want to.

Session 2- Please complete the editing activities for capital letters and full stops. Make sure you write this by hand in the notebook provided. This is a good chance for you to practise your handwriting too. The answers are at the end so you can check how you did.

Session 3- Please work through the PowerPoint that explains singular (one) and plural (more than one) nouns. Remember a noun is the name of a person, place or thing. Nouns can be more than one thing but there are a few different rules on how to write nouns as a plural.

Session 4- Please complete the activities on plurals. When coming up with your own nouns that could be singular or plural use things in your house, garden or that you see on a walk. Can you then write these in a sentence? I would love to see what you find, so please upload these to Google Classroom.

Session 5- Free write- Use the question to write your own piece on the picture. Make sure you include the targets that have been sent to you. I would love to see what you have written so please upload it to Google Classroom.
