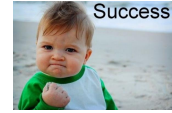

Need some help?

😊 If a word ends with **ch, sh, ss, x, z or o** then add **es**.

Box **x** → Boxes

😊 If a word ends with **y** then lose the **y** and add **ies**.

Baby → Babies

😊 If a word end with **f** then lose the **f** and add **ves**.

Wolf **f** → Wolves

For each letter write three words where you add

- a) **s**
- b) **es**
- c) Change **y** to **i** and add **es**
- d) Change **f** to **v** and add **es**

Only start this task once you have double checked all your answers for the previous tasks. 😊
