
Plurals

If a word ends with ch, sh, ss, x, z or o then add es.

Box→ Boxes

If a word ends with y then lose the y and add ies.

Baby → Babies

If a word end with f then lose the f and add ves.

Wolf → Wolves

- a) **s**
- b) **es**
- c) Change y to i and add es
- d) Change f to v and add es
