To my English group,

I hope you had a productive week last week. I am missing our lessons together and am thinking of you. I enjoyed seeing some of the work you are completing and how well you were doing it! I am looking forward to seeing some more of your work in your books when you get back and to hear about all the stories you have read.

Below you will find an explanation of the learning I have set you for this week. All this learning can be completed in the notebook you took home from school or one you have at home. This is a good chance to practise your handwriting! Also, you can edit it on the computer and save the changes. This way you don't need to print anything off and can still share your learning with me by uploading the edited document or a photo of the work to Google Classroom. A letter went out on the 30th March to explain how to do this. I really do want to see what amazing work you have being doing, so don't forget to attach pictures of it in Google Classroom.

English

Session 1- Spellings- Please practise the common exception words in the activity booklet, completing the activities to help. Once you have done this, continue to practise the spellings throughout the week, writing them out and writing sentences. Once you are confident, ask someone at home to test you on them. Let me know how you do. You can also continue practising all of the common exception words and completing the Mr Whoops activities if you want to.

Session 2- Please have a go at the question mark, exclamation mark or full stop activity. Which piece of punctuation do you think is correct? Then have a go at writing your own sentences using the pictures.

Session 3- Work through the PowerPoint on the conjunctions 'when', 'because' and 'if'. There are activities for you to try and you can see the answers afterwards to make sure you got it correct. Finish by having a go at writing your own sentences.

Session 4- Have a go at the activities for using the conjunctions 'so', 'but', 'and', 'or'. Then have a go at using this week's spelling words to write sentences using these conjunctions. Make sure your sentences make sense.

Session 5- Free write- Use the question to write your own piece on the picture. Make sure you include the targets that have been sent to you. I would love to see what you have written so please upload it to Google Classroom.

Session 1- Making inferences from pictures- have a look at the picture and answer the questions. Making an inference is when we reach a conclusion about something from the facts we know. For example, if an author wrote that the character put up her umbrella when she stepped out of the house, we can assume that it is raining outside.

Session 2- Please continue working through Words First Book 10.

Session 3- I am looking forward to hearing about all the books you have read while we have not been at school. Therefore, I would like you to use this session to read a book of your choice. Make a comfy area to sit and maybe read to a family member or a teddy bear/toy of your choice.
