This week, your learning will continue to be accessible in the same ways; you can use Google Classroom or the school website. Please try to use Google Classroom to hand in your work as much as possible. Not only do we love seeing it but it also helps us to see what we need to plan for you all next. Please remember, you can take photos of your hand- written work and upload them so that we can see that too.

Remember, you do not need to print the activities to complete them. You can display your work on your laptop, tablet or phone, or write your answers clearly on a piece of paper. If you prefer, you can write or type onto the worksheets.

Can we remind you again to make sure you are using the Stream to share work and photos with the other children in your year and provide polite, kind comments on other children's posts. If you need to ask a question, please use the private comments option on the piece of work you need help with and a teacher will get back to you as soon as possible.

You will find a summary of the learning for this week below. Please make sure you are also logging on to Spelling Shed, Times Table Rock Stars and Read Theory at least three times a week. Well done to those children who are logging in every day, this is really reflected in how much those children's scores have improved.

<u>Maths</u>

This week, you are thinking about angles. You will need a protractor for this. If you do not have one, you can download an app version for using on a phone or tablet. There are some 'free' protractor apps and you only need a standard protractor so look carefully if you choose to download one.

For four of the sessions, you have a worksheet to complete and there is a link to a video to watch (the videos are available through Vimeo this week not the White Rose Website). There is a reasoning activity to try after you have completed the White Rose learning.

All of the answer sheets are available on the Google Classroom page. Please mark your work and have another go at any questions you have not answered correctly before you submit, just like you would in class.

- Session 2 Drawing lines and angles accurately.
- Session 3 Calculating angles on a straight line.
- Session 4 Calculating angles around a point.
- Session 5 Arithmetic Check.

Session 5 - Free Write Friday! You have a quick grammar activity to warm you up before you complete your task **or** finish and edit your Home-Schooling balanced argument (depending on how you got in session 4).
