Welcome to the second part of the Summer Term which is your final half term at Wooden Hill Primary School.

Although changes to the way we are currently learning *may* occur at some point, the next few weeks, at least, will be exactly the same as how we have been doing our learning. You are all still safely at home and working using Google Classroom. As always, you are expected to complete the tasks and upload them for us to see.

Phone calls this week will remain as usual with Owl Class receiving theirs on Monday and Kite Class receiving theirs on Wednesday. Please remember that these conversations should be based around the learning and your wellbeing. If you, or your parent/carer, have any questions about returning to school, please make sure your adult puts the question into an email and sends it to the school office so we can ensure you get the correct answers to your questions.

This week, you have five maths sessions, five English sessions, three reading sessions and a topic project to last the week. They are as follows:

<u>Maths</u> - This week, your maths learning will focus on decimals. Remember to log into White Rose Maths (using the link on Google Classroom) to teach you what you must do.

Session 1 - Multiply and divide by 10, 100 and 1000, True or False question and Problem of the Day

Session 2 - Multiply decimals by integers, True or False question and Problem of the Day

Session 3 - Divide decimals by integers, True or False question and Problem of the Day

Session 4 - Decimals as fractions, True or False question and Problem of the Day

Session 5 - Fluent Friday and Challenge Day

Writing - This week, you are looking at persuasive writing

Session 1 - Look at vocabulary linked to persuasive writing

Session 2 - Practise being persuasive and locate persuasive writing in a text

Session 3 - Revise using quotations

Session 4 - Plan and design a new gadget

Session 5 - Plan write and edit a persuasive advertisement.

<u>Reading</u> - This week, you are going to be reading all about the great compose Beethoven.

Session 1 - Read the text, complete vocabulary work and make a list of key facts

Session 2 – Answer comprehension questions

Session 3 – Summarise what you have learned by creating a fact file on Beethoven.

Topic - This week, you are going to be thinking about an exhibition for a museum. You will be looking around the Natural History Museum, exploring some of their exhibitions and then thinking of your own, choosing exhibits to add and then advertising your exhibition.

Objective 1 – Take a virtual tour of the Natural History Museum

Objective 2 – Explore some of their exhibitions and displays

Objective 3 – Think of your own idea and make a mind map

Objective 4 - Choose and justify your exhibits

Objective 5 – Develop your ideas further and/or design advertising and marketing materials.

<u>Reminders</u> - Don't forget that you should also be using Spelling Shed, Times Table Rock Stars and Read Theory **three times a week** as well as continuing to read for **at least 15 minutes a day**.

Well done to the recipients of the 'Star of the Week' award from the week before half term. Remember that each week we will be nominating children that have done some amazing things at home. Make sure you show us what you have been getting up to by uploading pictures and information onto the 'Stream' section of Google Classrooms.
