



Summer 1 - Week 1 - Home Learning

Dear Year 6,

After two weeks of Easter Holidays, we hope that you have had some time to relax, eat lots of chocolate but find ways to exercise and keep healthy! We've certainly enjoyed our two weeks off but back to work it is. We were incredibly impressed and proud of how you all adapted to this new way of learning: using Google Classrooms. We have loved reading your comments on the stream and seeing the outcomes of the work submitted.

After conversations with some parents, we know that some people are panicking because they do not have a printer. Please know that a printer is not necessary for any work. Just as in class, you can use the information on the screen and write your responses directly into your exercise book, a notebook or onto pieces of paper. Many children have also begun to write up their work onto the computer and edit documents sent out.

To make this easier for you, we have several document types and ways of turning in your work. Firstly, some of our documents are now editable. This means that you can write your answers directly into the word document (see the Reading tasks to understand what we mean). In addition to this, we are also giving you options for how to complete tasks: either use your exercise book, a notebook or a piece of paper to complete tasks, take a picture of your work and submit this to Google Classroom OR complete the task on your computer using Google Docs or a Microsoft Office application and upload this to Google Classroom.

This week, you have five maths sessions, five English sessions, three reading sessions and a history project to complete. An outline of these can be found on the next page:

Maths - This week, your maths learning will continue to focus on shape and angles. Remember to log into White Rose Maths (using the link on Google Classroom) to teach you what you must do.

Session 1 - Vertically opposite angles, True or False question and Problem of the Day

Session 2 - Angles in a triangle, True or False question and Problem of the Day

Session 3 - Angles in a triangle special cases, True or False question and Problem of the Day

Session 4 - Missing angles in a triangle, True or False question and Problem of the Day

Session 5 - Fluent Friday Arithmetic Paper

Writing - This week, you are going to be writing a newspaper report based on a Pobble 365 image.

Session 1 - Study the image and write a summary answering the following questions: When? Where? What? Who? and Why?

Session 2 - Read teacher model and create a 'Boxed Success Criteria' from this

Session 3 - Plan a newspaper report using 'Paragraph Plan'

Session 4 - Write newspaper report

Session 5 - Edit and publish

Reading - This week, you are going to be reading a discursive text about evacuation during World War 2.

Session 1 - Read the text and complete vocabulary activity

Session 2 - Looking at text features: purpose of paragraphs and literary devices used

Session 3 - Answer the comprehension questions about the text and optional extension activity

Topic - This week, you are going to be completing your History Project based on World War Two. To remind you of what should be completed:

Week 1 - You should have chosen an area to study and researched this area

Week 2 - You should have sorted your research into a logical order and thought about how you would share the information

Week 3 - You should have begun to put all of your information together

Week 4 - This week, you need to complete and submit your work to Google Classroom

Reminders - Don't forget that you should also be using Spelling Shed, Times Table Rock Stars and Read Theory **three times a week** as well as continuing to read for **at least 15 minutes a day**.
