

Writing - Summer 1 Week 5 - Home Learning

Session 5

Today is all about performance. Poems and creative writing really come alive when they are read out loud and performed. You could just do this for yourself, or for your family or record it and send it to other people you know to cheer them up or inspire them to do their own.

What to do:

You can choose either your poem from session 1 this week or your edited descriptive paragraph from session 3. Use the top tips below to ensure you are prepared for your performance. Once you are happy with your performance, record it yourself or have someone record it for you. We can't wait to hear/see your performances!

Top Tips for performing your writing:

- ★ Know your writing/poem really well so you can focus on the performance
- ★ Think about the tone of voice you are going to use on certain words or lines. Can you slow down, speed up or emphasise certain parts?
- ★ As you are reading your work aloud, you may hear certain parts that don't sound quite right or jar. This is a chance for you to edit and improve!
- ★ Be confident and enjoy it! Try not to re-record yourself 1000 times trying to make it perfect.
- ★ Speak really clearly so that your audience can hear each precious word.

How to share your work:

- Record your performance on a smartphone/device.

Once you've completed the work, submit your work to Google Classroom following this set of instructions:

1. Go to classroom.google.com
2. Click the class - Classwork - the assignment.
3. To attach an item, click 'Add or create' and select 'Google Drive', 'Link' or 'File' depending on what type of file you have created.
4. The status of your work will change to 'Turned in'.
