

## Personal, Social and Emotional Development

### Making relationships

- Can play in a group, extending and elaborating play ideas.
- Initiates play, offering cues for peers to join them.
- Demonstrates friendly behaviour, initiating conversations and forming good relationships.
- Initiates conversations and takes account of what others say.



### Self-confidence and self-awareness

- Can select and use activities and resources with help.
- Welcomes and values praise for what they have done and enjoys the responsibility of carrying out small tasks.
- Confident to speak to others about own needs, wants and opinions.



## Managing feelings and behaviour

- Aware of own feelings, and knows that some actions and words can upset others.
- Begins to accept the needs of others and can take turns and share, sometimes with support.
- Can usually tolerate delay, and understands that wishes may not always be met.
- Awareness of boundaries set, and of behavioural expectations in the setting.
