Year Five

What to bring to school:

Jay class will have PE on Mondays and Wednesdays. PE kit should be in school every day.

Children do not need pencil cases as we have all of the equipment they need.

Children should bring a named water bottle to school daily.

Children will have chosen a reading book that is the correct colour band for them. This should be brought to school daily along with their reading record.

Please ensure your child always has appropriate clothing for the weather.



Reading:

Children should be reading at home at least 4 times weekly (ideally every day). They should be reading their banded reading book regularly but it is also important for them to engage with a range of texts.

Children have been given a reading record which they will have checked weekly. Any reading at home, including non-school books, should be recorded, even if they haven't read with an adult.

Children will be given a sticker for each time they read at home when the reading records are checked. When children fill up a side of their bookmark, they will be given a prize.



Rewarding Good Attitudes to Learning:

At Wooden Hill, we expect all children to follow the school rules at all times therefore good behaviour is not rewarded individually.

Children will receive dojo points for demonstrating positive attitudes to learning, outstanding effort and good learning behaviours.



Homework:

Children should be regularly practising their times tables and spellings.

Children will receive weekly spellings which will also be posted to the website. These spellings will link to the rule they are learning in their spelling lessons.

Children have access to both Times Table Rock Stars and the Pixl times table app to help them to practise.
