Dear Parents and Carers,

Thank you to all parents who have been supporting their children at home to learn their number bonds and times tables. Many of you have been using the PiXL times tables app and Times Tables Rockstars app with great success!

For those of you whose children are in Year 2, so new to this, or who have not yet successfully logged on at home, Times Tables Rockstars is a fun app which teachers use to allocate tables and games to your child and are then able to track their achievements. To access the app you can either download it free from the app store or find it online at <https://trockstars.com/>. The app has been set up so that your child can log on with the same login details that they use for the PiXL app.

Your child has already been given their login details which you will find stuck into their reading record. The app is very child friendly as the children choose an avatar to start with and gain coins when they play the games. We then track progress in school and celebrate success in assemblies. The children will also play these games in school on the school iPads and laptops.

We also have access to another PiXL app called PiXL unlock. This can also be downloaded from the app store. It works in a very similar way to the PiXL times table app but the focus of this one is on vocabulary. The same login details can be used for this app and, again, we can track how children are progressing through the games in school.

If you have any questions about any of these apps, or if your login details are not working, please ask in the office as they have a list of the details for each child.
