English 'Star in the Jar'

In this unit , the children will:

- Read 'Star in the Jar' by Sam Hay.
- Write a narrative story.
- Understand how to use onomatopoeia, adverbs, similes and adjectives to write effective sentences.
- Punctuate writing correctly.
- Understand a characters feelings and use actions to convey this through writing.

Key vocabulary:

Feelings, noticing, verbs (actions), speech, dialogue, adverbs, similes, onomatopoeia, alliteration, personification, pathetic fallacy, punctuation.

Maths Place value

In this unit , the children will:

- Represent numbers to 100.
- Understand the value of 100s, 10s and 1s.
- Use number lines up to 1000.
- Identify the value of intervals on a number line.
- Compare amounts using greater than, less than and equal to.
- Find 1, 10 and 100 more and less.
- Ordering numbers.

Key vocabulary:

Hundreds, tens, ones, number line, intervals, greater than, less than, equal to, place value, ascending, descending, more, less.
