Key Vocabulary:

Environment— the natural world of land, sea, air, plants, and animals.

Recycling — the act of processing used materials into new products for further use.

Pollution — poisonous or dirty substances that are polluting the water, air, or land somewhere.

Impact — The impact that something has on a situation, process, or person is a sudden and powerful effect that it has on them.
