English and Maths Knowledge Organiser

English—Star in the Jar

In this unit, the children will:

- Read *Star in the Jar* by Sam Hay.
- Learn how to use onomatopoeia, adverbs, fronted adverbials, similes, pathetic fallacy and personification to add suitable description to their writing.
- Use basic and further forms of punctuation correctly.
- Understand a character's feelings and responses, use actions to convey this through writing.
- Write a narrative story independently.

Key vocabulary: narrative, setting, instructions, verb, noun, adverb, adverbials, inference, literal, deduction, negative and positive intent.

Maths—Place Value, Addition and Subtraction

In this unit, the children will:

- Read and write numbers up to 1000.
- Round, count, represent and partition numbers up to 1000.
- Compare numbers up to 1000—more/less.
- Count in multiples of 25 and 1000.
- Count backwards through 0 to negative numbers.
- Add and subtract numbers with up to 4 digits using formal written methods.
- Solve 2 step addition and subtraction problems.

Key vocabulary: thousands, hundreds, tens, ones, multiple, compare, round, represent, partition, digit, addition, subtraction, more, less.
