



# HEADTEACHER UPDATE

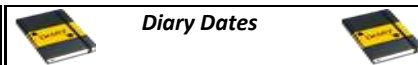
Dear Parents / Carers,

In science we have been learning about different animal groups through funky songs and comparing their features. Max even brought a real snake's skin in for us to observe and touch.
