Year 1 round up!

Year 1 have been thoroughly enjoying their new topic 'Out of this world'. Over the term the children have learnt about Neil Armstrong and how rockets work. They have explored old and new transport, discussing which transport they would use for which journey. They have made their own timelines and placed pictures in chronological order.

In Maths lessons this term they have learnt about addition and subtraction and learnt to use part whole models. The children have used number lines to jump and compared numbers using the greater and less than symbols.

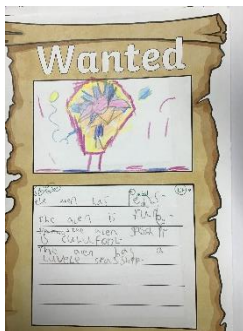
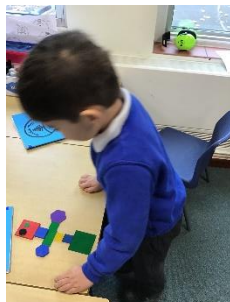
Parking
