<b>Endemic species</b>	A organism that only lives in a particular place and is specially adapted.
<b>Native species</b>	An organism currently that naturally lives in an area.
<b>Invasive species</b>	An organism that does not naturally live in an area which has harmful effects.
<b>Natural resources</b>	Something that is found in nature and can be used by people.
<b>El Nino event</b>	The reoccurring warming of ocean temperatures.

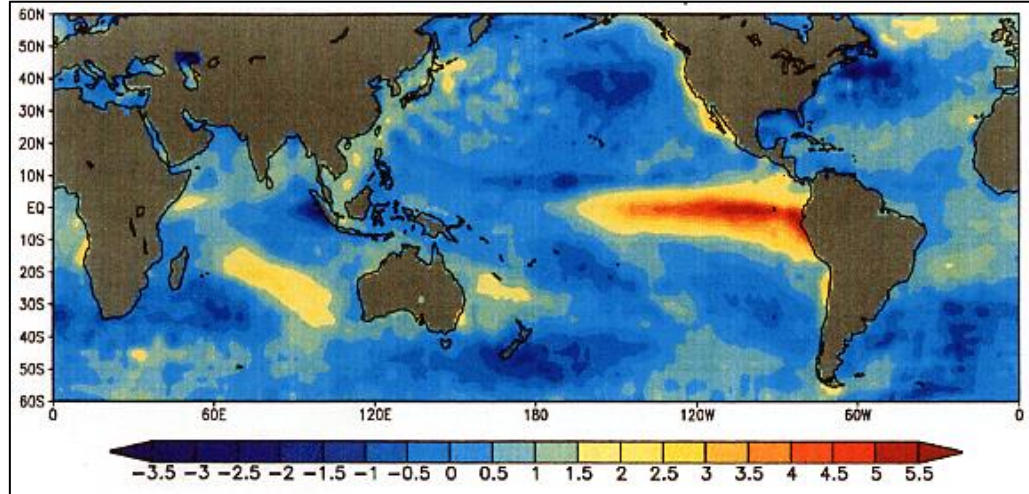
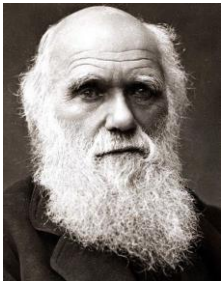


Diagram showing the ocean temperatures during the El Nino event in 1997.
