Science Seasons and Materials

In this unit, the children will:

- Explore different materials and their properties.
- Learn about Spring and what happens to the temperature and rainfall in this season by writing a
 weather diary.
- Discuss trees and how they change throughout Spring by drawing a field sketch.

Key learning—Seasons

- The children will learn to make observational drawings of a spring deciduous tree.
- The children will measure the temperature and rainfall in Spring and keep a weather diary to track it.
- The children will discuss the features of Spring and what happens to animals in this time.



What came before:

In Spring 1, the children explored the topic 'Seasons and Materials' for Winter.

What comes next:

In Summer 1 the children will explore the topic 'Seasons' for Summer.
