



Geography Imagination Island

In this unit, children will learn about the differences between weather and climate. Children will learn about basic climate zones and the conditions in cold, hot and temperate climate zones. They will use world maps and globes to identify the UK and the main British Islands. Children will identify weather patterns in the UK and the location of hot and cold areas of the world. They will explore the island of Madagascar, including Lemur Island. Children will compare life in Kenya with the UK.




This map shows the **different climate zones** around the world.
